This was just reward for a tireless display by Murphy – probably his best for Boden. Starting the final period of ten minutes, Crokes sent over a point to leave the minimum in it. Then, disaster struck for Boden as a loose ball was picked up and fired to the net – Crokes two in front. Both of these teams know the meaning of character and once again this was displayed. In the very next attack, the ball found its way to Fionn Maguire on the edge of the square. Under severe pressure, he got his shot away and it dropped nicely into the net beyond the reach of the Crokes 'keeper. A further point by Crokes tied the game and we wondered how this match could possibly finish. Players had given everything, cramp was setting in and there were a few added minutes to prolong the tension. In these final ten minutes, substitute James Madden covered a huge amount of ground and won key turnover ball. Donal Butler tidied up superbly and delivered intelligent ball to the midfield. From one of these deliveries, Chris Lambert drew a foul and Roche calmly fired over from out on the right. The final act took the same player into the left corner, from where he sent over the insurance point and so ended an epic contest on a scoreline of Boden 1-14 to Crokes 1-12. This will keep us going over Christmas and we look forward to the County Final against Na Fianna in the New Year.
