



Siúltóirí Buadáin

Siúltóirí Buadáin took to the **Glencree Valley** on Saturday and undertook the challange of Djouce. Djouce from Crone Wood is a great winter mountain trek. Its terrain is diverse and offers all that one requires when out on the mountains.... woods, forrest trails, a waterfall, a river crossing and steep tough climbs.From every angle there are magnificant views over Powercourt Demesne and Parklands and the majestic **Powerscourt Waterfall.**Djouce, although stark and imposing is perhaps the more popular mountain among the Dublin Wicklow Range and draws many trekkers to its slopes at the weekends.

Other popular treks among walking groups are the coastal walks along the Eastern Shores south of Dublin. On Saturday a large number of Na Siúltóirí took to the coast, parked up in Kilcoole, walked to Greystones ,chatted over cups of coffee and did a return walk back to Kilcoole.

This easy grade walk is overlooked and guarded by the Dublin Wiclow hills and offers wonderful views over Dublin Wicklow Bay. The coast line is a haven for Shore Anglers and Birdwatchers and their presence add greatly to the peace and tranquility of this beautiful walk.
