All of you, who have clicked in and enjoyed the magic of Eamonn's work, will appreciate our decision to head up to Fairy Castle again on Saturday.

Our route took us along the full crest of Tibraddan Hill. We trekked in all weathers. We encountered ice, snow, gale force winds, rain and even a little sunshine. Our trekking skills were put to practice and our abilities to tread tentatively over ice and trudge through impacted snow were tested.

The trails were a hive of activity on Saturday with mountain runners challenging themselves to finish their race in good time and with parents and their children enjoying some family time together.

Each time you trek a mountain a new experience is born, so true of Fairy Castle.On the other side of the hills a group of Na Siúltóirí took on the trek from Brennanstown to Carrickgollogan Hill. Carrickgollogan Hill and its surrounds are managed by The Dublin Mountain Partnership. The panoramic views from it summit over South Dublin and North Wicklow is spectacular and its woods are a fine habitat for badgers, rabbits and a large variety of birds.

Na Siúltóirí intended to carry on over from Carrickgollogan to the Scalp but weather conditions prevailed and instead of the ice and snow that their fellow walkers were experiencing, their path to The Scalp was flooded. There was no way through. How diverse the elements can be on the Dublin Wicklow Hills.

No matter the weather, the enthuasism among our walkers is infectious. It is heartening that each week Na Siúltóirí gather in growing numbers to trek the hills and each week they return to trek some more.
