Na Siúltóirí Buadáin - Upcoming Schedule

Speaker Connolly, a wealthy bussiness man constructed a hunting lodge on Mt Pelier Hill in 1725. When its roof was blown off by a strong gale force wind, locals attributed the misfortune to the fact that Connolly destroyed a cairn in the construction of the lodge. He replaced the roof with an arch one of stone. Some years after his death, the lodge was taken over by 'the infamous Hellfire Club'. Hellfire clubs, established in the eighteenth century were associated with outrageous behaviour and depravity. The HellFire Club, as we know it today, is a famous landmark and commands a magnificent view over Dublin.

Na Siúltóiri took on the Hellfire Club walk on Wednesday. Although the day was windy and wet, the shelter of the forest shielded us from the elements as we trekked up to the landmark and back via Kilakee Gardens in Massey's Wood. Our walk in Masseys along by the stream added a wonderful sense of tranquility to our afternoon, having listened to Conor relating the history of the Hellfire and all its wild stories.

Saturday dawned Spring perfect. The Blessington lakes and the surrounding hills and countryside of North West Wicklow looked splendid as we trekked over Sorrel Hill on this second day of the season. The bright morning sunshine erased the memories of dark dreary Winter days from our thoughts.

The approach to the round topped granite hill brought us through forest tracks, farmer's lands and country lanes. Traces of frost on the open tracks provided a stepping board over the soft spongy terrain and ensured a footing from the boggy potholes.

From our vantage point at the megalithic cairn on top of Sorrel, the contrast between the snow capped distant mountains and the Sun's reflection on the Blessington lakes was amazing. After some sustenance on Sorrel we returned by Lacken Village. Lacken's location on the shore of the lakes is idyllic and so unspoiled. It is picture postcard.

We had a record turnout on Saturday, 34 Siúltóirí in all and each of us returned home enriched and renewed by the beauty of the hills we had trekked.
