#### **Update from Lotto Committee**

Over the past number of years the amount of club Lotto players has fallen. The Lotto is a vital income for the running of the club. Last year despite a lot of effort, the Lotto Committee saw a limited increase in the sale of Lotto Tickets



In December 2012 the Lotto Committee visited most of the teams in Ballyboden St.Endas to enlist there help. These teams have agreed to help and drive the sale of tickets amongst their players. More teams have to be visited this month.

If each player or family were to play €2 on a regular basis it would help double the contribution from the Lotto to the Club for much needed funds. These funds to be

used in the day to day running of the Club and capital projects. The current capital project is the building of the ball wall in Sancta Maria (excess €90,000).

On average 50% is paid out in prize money. Last week saw Kathryn Coffey win €9,500!...There are 12 monthly draws of €150 and a separate monthly draw for hotel breaks for yearly subscribers. Weekly match 3 winners.
