The loop walk around the two lakes of Bohernabreena Reservoir.

The Dublin Mountains Way spans 40K across the mountains from Shankill to Tallaght. Officially opened in October 2010, The Way has become a popular trail for hill walkers.

The Reservoir Loop Walk set within the backdrop of Kiltipper Mountain in Glen Na Smol, is a very scenic walk. The reeds and rushes on the shores of the lakes are a haven for wildlife and the tranquille surroundings offer the ideal setting for anglers fishing for trout. The lakes are stocked annually and fishing is by permit only. Running parallel with the lakes is The River Dodder.

The high peat content in its waters gives the River a rich copper colour, enhancing the foliage along its banks.

Na Siúltóiri enjoyed their Wednesday walk around this wonderful recreational amemity. It is very well maintained by Dublin City Council and we are so lucky we are to have it on our doorstep.

On Saturday, thirty walkers "togged out" for the Djouce walk, including some new walkers, well done to everybody in completing the climb.

Weather as ideal as can be expected for the time of year, strong wind at the top, superb sunshine on return added a great sense of Springtime to the day and an awakening of nature after its long winter sleep.
