good ball carrying play with a well worked goal. The home team replied with a goal of their own from *Colm O'Neill*. This settled Boden and an opportunist goal and point from *James Madden* had the home team 2-03 to 1-01 ahead at half time.

Siúltóirí Buadáin get to see many wonderful places. As a talented bunch, or so we like to think, would excel on any stage. So this week we went to Hollywood. On arrival a bus load of Americans, clearly thrilled at spotting Na Siúloirí waved and cheered as we trekked down the main street. We responded of course with a wave here and a nod there. **OH!** Did I mention that we were in Hollywood Co Wicklow and not LA! aLSO, the coach load of Americans along with waving to us, were also waving in acknowledgement, that the **HOLLYWOOD** sign overlooking the village, is a replica of the sign in Los Angeles.

Hollywood, historically known as **'Cillín Chaoimhín'** (Kevin's little church), is a lovely picturesque village in Co Wicklow. It was from here, in the 6th century, that St Kevin began his journey to Glendalough, where he laid the foundations of the first and most famous of the Irish Monastic sites that dawned the age of Christianity in Ireland. Na Siúltóirí retraced part of Kevin's journey along what is known as *'The St Kevin's Way'* on Saturday.

The route, on farmer's lanes and over rolling hillside is gentle and tranquile. The wild flowers rekindled memories of children picking their favourites to place on The May Altar
