The next 5 minutes had Kilmacud forcing the play, however their only return was 5 wides after some good tackling by the Boden backs forced their forwards to shoot under pressure. From then on, with Warren Egan and James Madden dominating midfield, some excellent passing moves were finished off in style by Colm O'Neill, Conor Deane and two well taken goals from Adam Carney. Determined not to let the home team back into the game, Cian Bates scored an early second half point. Another brace by Adam Carney and two well taken points from Colm O'Neill and James Madden saw Kilmacud heads drop.

Things were to get worse for Crokes after they had a player sent off for 2 yellow cards and their challenge faded. Score of the game came from Brian O'Shea as he pushed upfield to finish off an excellent passing move by crashing the ball to the net. Well done to all the squad. The lads now have a well-deserved break for July so they come back refreshed in August for the preparations for Championship.
