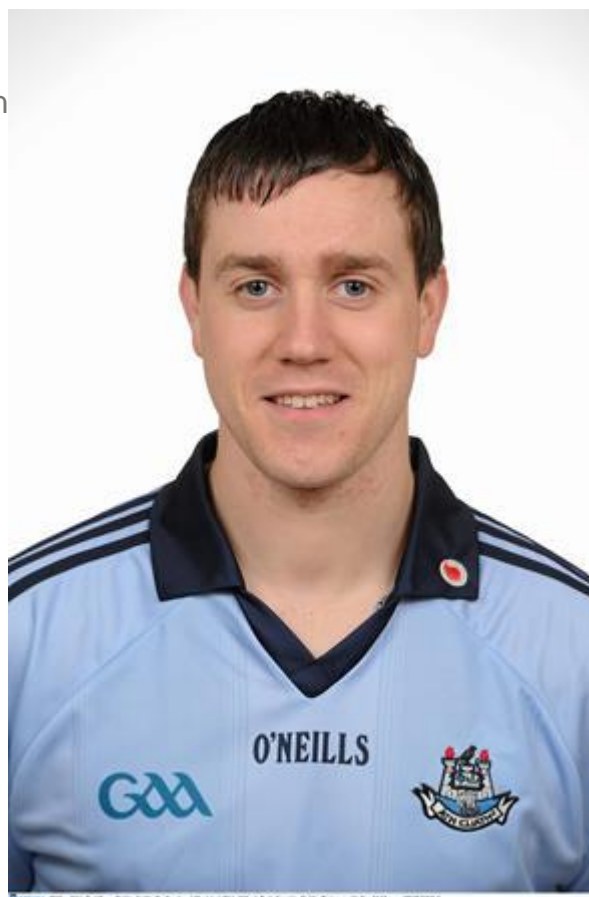

## Paul Ryan wins GAA/ GPA award for July

A stand-out performance from Paul Ryan in the Leinster SHC Final against Galway, just a week after their replay victory over Kilkenny, saw Dublin secure the county's first Leinster senior hurling title in 52 years. The display has him the GAA GPA Player of the Month Awards for July. The Ballyboden St. Endas man scored an impressive 2-7 in the match, setting Dublin up for a semi-final showdown against Cork next Sunday. Cian Mackey of Cavan is the football recipient.

GAA Commenting on the announcement, Uachtarán Chumann Lúthchleas Gael, Liam Ó Néill said: "It's been an incredible summer to date in both championships in no small part thanks to the breakthrough victories of counties starved of success. "Dublin's hurling emergence in Leinster was as impressive as any and Paul Ryan played his part in that win with an eye catching corner forward display.
