# Senior footballers bow out of Championship

The Senior footballers were knocked out of the SFC last night by St Vincents by 4-12: 0-15. The Old adage of "Goals win games" was never more true than at a chilly Parnell Park last night when 3 first half strikes put paid to any hope of a 3rd SFC title.

The Boden were hit with the first goal after only 2 minutes when Dublin star Diarmuid Connolly drove a great strike past Daire Walsh, after an early effort had been missed. But the lads settled quickly after that blow, and 3 frees from Andy Kerin sandwiched between a wonderful long range Donagh McCabe point brought the team back to within a point before the 2nd



goal, this time by Vin's full forward Ciaran Dorney on 17 minutes. 6 minutes later and corner back Kevin Bonnie was allowed too much space to finish a 3rd goal. The Boden to their credit got the game back to 2 points at half time with Kenny Naughton rolling back the years with 3 great first half points which meant the gap was back to 2 points at half time - **BBSE 0-10 : 3-03 St Vincents** 

After playing with a stiff breeze in the first half it looked like the seniors were in trouble at half time, but they had shown great courage in previous rounds to come back from behind. They started the 2nd half well with an Andy Kerin pointed free after another foul on full forward Conal Keaney. Having missed a chance to equalise, Vincents punished Boden with 1-2 in the space of 2 minutes - Connolly with his 2nd of the night. The gap was now 6 points and the large Boden contingent began to fear the worst. And worse it almost was on 37 minutes after a foot block led to a penalty to Vincents. Mossie Quinn stood up, and curled the ball just wide of the post. This let off rallied the Boden lads who never gave up on the night.

The Boden needed goals to get back into it, and with 8 minutes to go a great run from Michael Darragh Macauley ended with Keaney cracking a rasping shot off the crossbar. That would have reduced the gap to 4 points but that bit of luck that is needed in any game was just missing last night. Sam's visit will now take place on *Sunday November 17th*. More details to follow closer to the date, please keep an eye out on the website.




