Ballyboden made the stronger start when, after a couple of opening points for each team, **Gavin Corrigan** struck for a crucial goal. Vincents responded strongly to close the gap and for the rest of the half points were traded. The northside team started brightly against the breeze in the second half but a series of well-taken frees from **Colm O'Neill** saw Boden pull clear. A crucial score in the third quarter was a magnificent sideline cut by **Finn McDonagh** who had a fine overall game. Boden stood firm in this period, best typified by a superb shoulder challenge by captain Naoise Maguire, that put a stop to a strong St Vincents run from midfield.

## Football News - Big Weekend Ahead for Seniors and U21s




