Football News - Minor A Championship

Minor A Championship match v Kilmacud.

The minor A Football semi-final, played in the scenic Stars of Erin pitch in Glencullen on Sunday, proved to be a step too far for a gallant Ballyboden side who came up against a well-drilled Kilmacud outfit.

The match started brightly for Ballyboden against hill and wind. A point from Adam Carney and an early free from Barra McGarry promised a great performance. Alas it was not to be. Team captain Brian Bobbett suffered an ankle injury after 10 minutes and although he bravely carried on, Ballyboden seemed to lose momentum from that point on. Kilmacud managed to pin the Ballyboden defence in their own half of the field with superb tackling and intensity. Kilmacud racked up 9 points without reply and it was in the fourth minute of injury time that Ballyboden got their next score, another point from a free from Barry McGarry.

Half time score Kilmacud 0-9; BBSE 0-3.

Ballyboden had hill and wind in second half but Kilmacud made their intentions clear from the throw in, winning almost every breaking ball and notching up an early point. It took Ballyboden 15 minutes to get on the scoresheet, a goal from Adam Carney which brought the score back to four points. However, from there on Kilmacud found their scoring boots and two goals, one from a penalty sealed a well-deserved victory for Kilmacud. A late consolation goal from Barra McGarry only served to improve the look of the scoreline; in truth Ballyboden were well-beaten in almost every department on the day.

For team manager, Liam Deane and coaches, Ciaran Doyle and Fergal Brennan, this will be a hugely disappointing end to a good season. The commitment shown by players under team captain Brian Bobbett was excellent and the players themselves will be first to admit that they did not perform on the day.

Ballyboden had good performances from Oisín Ó Dúill, Stephen Ward and Brian Bobbett in defence while Barra McGarry and Adam Carney was the pick of the forwards.

Coaching - Athletic Development Workshop

The Coaching & Games Executive ran an Athletic Development workshop last Thursday in St. Colmcilles National School for all U13 to U16 mentors. During the 70 minute presentation some of the topics covered were:

What are Functional/Fundamental Movement Skills?

Why we need to work on them with our players?

And How can we work on them in training and how can we get the players to work on these skills at home?



The 40 plus mentors who were in attendance listened to the theory behind Functional Movement Skills before being put through a series of strengthening and flexibility exercises that they can use with the players on their teams.

Putting together an Athletic Development plan as part of the overall Player Pathway from Juvenile to Adult in the club was one of the key objectives that is set out in The Coaching & Games Development Plan for 2014
