playing in the rote, some playing in the rote exploits, Conal Keaney helped himself to two fine goals before the watching eyes of County chief, Tommy Lyons.


Just before the close, Tommy skipped away to beat the festive traffic, but by that stage, the Boden boys were in the mood for carol singing.

The best of luck to Robbie, Vincent and management team for the season ahead. They commence training this Wednesday night in Sancta Maria.


