Hurling - Senior B match reports

Ballyboden St Endas Senior B hurlers made it three wins from three when they were victorious in their Championship match against St Sylvesters in Sancta Maria on Thursday 4th June 2014. A tentative start by both teams saw the action concentrated in the middle third of the field and this, allied to a number of wides, left the score after the first quarter two points each. A feature of this first quarter also was a fine save by goalkeeper Conor Dooley. The forward's radar sparked into action in the second quarter and Boden began to take control. Pick of the scores were wonderful points from both corners by Jonathon O'Driscoll and Finnian McDonagh. This left the half-time score Boden 0-7 to Sylvesters' 0-3.

This was a championship match so it was no surprise that the northside team started brightly in the second half and registered the first green flag of the evening with a well-struck goal. This seemed to spring Boden into life as they rattled over the next five points without reply, the last being a peach of a point by McDonagh after a superb puckout catch, run and pass by

Adam Jermyn. The half-back line of Ronan Cleary, Jamie Desmond and Kenneth Wiggleswoth held firm as Sylvesters sought to claw back the lead. However, great work-rate by all but in particular, Eoghan O'Neill and Mattie Weldon in midfield, ensured their chances were at a minimum. Boden introduced some fresh legs in the final quarter and when Niall Ryan and Dermot Coffey registered white flags, the match was closed out on a scoreline of Boden 1-17 to Sylvesters' 1-7. Boden now top the Group 1 table on 6 pts with matches against Round Tower (2nd July) and Whitehall Colmcille (16th July) to come.

Ballyboden St Endas Senior B hurlers lined out for the second time in four days when they faced Setanta in round five of the Division 2 league in Sancta Maria on Saturday 7th June 2014. The team showed many changes from the championship match a few days earlier and had to withstand a bright opening spell from the Ballymun team who raced into a four point lead after ten minutes. Boden steadied and fine points from Adam Jermyn, Emmett Carroll and Mark Lambert saw them back to within a point. Strong running by Setanta, in particular Dublin U21 squad member, Fiontán McGib, meant they kept the pressure on. Niall Keegan was doing well, particularly under Setanta puckouts and one such win was followed by a super pass for another Jermyn point. After this however, Setanta began to dominate and finished the half strongly with a goal by McGib to leave the half-time score Ballyboden 0-9 Setanta 1-12.

Captain Darragh O'Gorman, who was having a fine game at full-back, rallied the troops at half-time. There is great fighting spirit in this team and following concession of a second goal to Setanta, the work-rate of the team increased. Paddy Ryan led from centre-back ably assisted by Keegan and Kenneth Wigglesworth. The first of four points by Mattie Weldon gave the team a lift and they got to within four points. Despite their best efforts they could not push Setanta any further and the northside team emerged on top on a scoreline of 2-18 to 0-17. Thank you to the players who stepped in for this match - well done to all. The team now has a well-earned break for a couple of weeks before the next league match against St Brigids on the 21st June.
