Another change led to the introduction of Kane O'Doherty who with his first touch ghosted past his man and grabbed Boden's fifth goal. Up by six points it seemed like game over but Raheny came again and manufactured a goal along with a couple of points to bring the deficit back to one. However Fee was to grab his hat trick when again a perfectly placed ball by Ciaran Murphy found the chunky full forward in space and he expertly converted. Boden repelled all further Raheny attacks lead by Ross Traynor, Michael Dunne and Donal Sheehan to close out the game. There was even time for Ciaran Murphy to race through on goal before throwing the ball up in the air to himself . No one really knows what he was doing then..
