83rd Annual Friendship Cumann na mBunscol Games 2014

Some of the future stars of Gaelic Games in Dublin and Belfast took to the field at Alfie Byrne Road in Dublin earlier in the Summer for a series of games under this friendship tournament between Dublin Cumann na mBunscoil and Antrim.

These games go back to the 1930s and have featured many children who have gone on to represent their respective counties with distinction.

Earlier that day, in the shadows of that fine Stadium, the U16s fared better with a convincing win over their hosts, despite a shaky start.

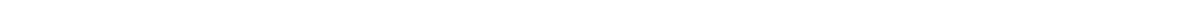

The Dublin Championship Draw 2014 has been made for U15 Footballers & Hurlers and the U16 Hurlers.

[The U15 Hurlers start off with the Quarter Finals on Sunday 24th August.](#)

The 'A's are in a group of 4 which include Naomh Barrog, Na Fianna and Lucan Sarsfields. They meet Naomh Barrog in their first outing, while the 'B's face St Maurs. Also included in the 'B's group are Lucan and Fingalians. **The semi finals take place on 07/09/14 with the final on 05/10/14.**

[The Football U/15 Championship 1st round kicks off on Sunday 14th September.](#)

The 'A's are up against Kilmacud Crokes, the 'B's play St Annes and the 'C's face Castleknock. In their 1st round group of 4, as the 'A's meet Crokes to decide who progresses, Lucan Sarsfields and Na Fianna battle it out for their place in the Quarter Finals. In the 'B' campaign, the winners of Boden and St.Annes will meet the victors of Fingal Ravens and Round Towers, Lucan and in the 'C' draw the winners of BBSE and Castleknock will compete against the winners of Lucan Sarsfields and Clontarf.

Quarter finals are on 28/09/14, Semis on 12/10/14 and the Final will be held on 02/11/14.

The U/16 Hurlers start their campaign on Saturday 6th September starting with a Quarter Final game against Kilmacud Crokes. The other quarter finalists in their group are Cuala and St. Vincents.

The semi finals are being held on 20/09/14 and the final on 18/10/14.
