Once again, goals win matches; and failure to take goal chances loses matches. Two goal chances missed in the first 5 minutes; another one or two missed later; a dodgy penalty awarded to Cuala which was saved by our stand-in goalie, Ciaran Archbold, but the more alert Cuala forward finished the rebound to the net; a mix-up in our defence allowed a Cuala forward to tap in for goal number 2; a penalty claim by us turned down. And we lose by one point.

Aran Waters and Daren O'Reilly scored early points which were cancelled out by two Cuala frees. Boden then went two points up after points by Collie Basquel and Sean Gibbons before the disastrous penalty on 12 minutes put Cuala one point up and almost immediately added a point from play. Declan O'Mahony from a free brought it back to one. Conor McCormack was shown a black card to on 25 minutes and was replaced by Brian Kirwan. Further points by Declan O'Mahony, Collie Basquel and Andrew Kerin (free) were cancelled out by similar scores by Cuala to leave them one point ahead at the break: 0 - 8 to 1 - 6.

Stephen Hiney had to retire due to injury early in the second half. Cuala scored a point in the first minute and their second goal arrived in the fourth minute. They scored four more points in the next 10 minutes with just two in reply from us by Collie Basquel and Andrew Kerin (free) to put them 7 points ahead. A great run by Collie Basquel, despite close marking, carried the ball into the danger area where he off-loaded to Tom Hanafin. As cool as you like he finished to the net. Game on with less than 10 minutes left. Tom added a point a couple of minutes later with Andrew Kerin adding two more (1 free). Sam Molony got a straight red with 5 minutes left. With normal time almost up, the hard-working Collie Basquel won a free out on the right hand side. Declan O'Mahony scored to make it level pegging with time up. Andrew Kerin received a second yellow and was accordingly dismissed and we were now down to 13 men. The referee played at least 5 minutes of added time which allowed Cuala to score the winning point, their first score in over 15 minutes.
