Late Surge is just enough for Boden to grab the points

Ballyboden Sen.A Hurlers 3.18 St. Brigids 2.13

A closing four minutes of pressure hurling was just about enough for our Senior hurlers to bag two league points in this Thursday evening fixture at Russell Park. After a late spell of 'scant croppings', the Boden forward line closed the game with four unanswered points from Stephen O'Connor, Simon Lambert, a great score from Niall Ryan, and the last score of the

evening from David Curtin. This was after our hosts had hit a purple patch and reduced a huge deficit to a manageable four points.

Brigids opened in a cautious mood and immediately installed their sweeper to operate in front of their full back line. But that did not have the desired effect as Boden chalked up a tally of 1 05 inside the opening ten minutes. Ryan got the goal after good spotting from goalman Keith Robinson. The other scores came from Lambert, O'Connor, David O'Connor and Austin Lynch.

Brigids had a few chances, missed most of them, but did point through Luke Purtell and Eoin Dunne, a fine piece of skill. Boden's fluency in the scoring area took 'time out' and allowed Brigids into the game with further scores from Mark Kavanagh and Sean Dunbar. Back came Boden and a flow of points, Stephen O'Connor with two neat ones. The half ended with an assist from Lynch to Conor McCormack and a cheeky line cut from Doc to the eager hands of Curtin. Half Time had it 1 10 to 0 05.

The second half opened in style for Boden and a fine goal from Lambert after a telling pass from Ryan, showing up as Boden's best forward of the opening thirty. Another to show some good form was Conor Robinson, grabbing a few scores as well as hovering up some loose ball around the middle. Simo now took on the responsibility entrusted to him at the point of the attack and bagged a point, and a further goal after good work outfield from Cian Mellett, a young man making his senior debut. Jamie Desmond, operating in an unaccustomed role in the forwards, placed Stephen O'Connor in space for a fine point and brought the score to 3 13 to 0 05.

The Brigids response was to abandon their defensive system and throw caution to the wind. It had the desired result and within a ten minute spell of quality hurling they scores 2 04, the best of the goals from Ciaran O'Sullivan. Ryan stopped the rot with a neat score, but back came Brigids with three further points, narrowing the gap to two scores, easily manageable in the closing five or so minutes. With Paul Carley and his side line team appealing for more effort, the whole fifteen came good and closed out the fixture with four unanswered points.

The result puts Boden on six league points, but at a further cost in terms of injuries, the most serious of them to Naoise Maguire. Upcoming fixtures include a home tie with Crumlin and the important Leinster League Final with Buffers Alley, a curtain raiser to the Dubs versus the Cats.


