## Minor A League Sunday 24th July Silver Park Ballyboden St Enda's 2-21 Kilmacud Crokes 1-9 Le Fear Bog

After being rolled over by St Vincent's the previous Wednesday Ballyboden Minor A's resurrected themselves to produce a storming victory over their Kilmacud opponents on Sunday last. Ballyboden, perhaps conscious of being relieved of their 100% record during the week, were slow out of the blocks in the first half. Possibly, it was a case of trying to amend for too many errors from the previous Wednesday but the fluidity of the boys play was absent and a certain tetchiness in their stick work set in. Despite dominating throughout the first half Ballyboden went in at the break with only the minimum of an advantage. The major talking point of the half was a penalty awarded to Kilmacud on the stoke of half time, erroneously in this viewers eyes as the ball had been fouled in the square rather than the man, which was converted by full forward Michael Roche. Having fluffed his lift Roche superbly drew on the sliothar on the ground to send it past Conor O'Donoghue in the Boden goal. Ballyboden completely dominated the second half and were full value for their 15 point win. It was a credit to these lads that they amassed 2-11 in that period, all of it from play. Daniel Nugent was tormentor in chief of the Crokes defence and he would finish the match with a total of 1-5. His goal in the 41st minute set Boden on their way and Shane Kennedy book ended the half with a glorious solo effort in the 58th minute. Ballyboden fired over some lovely scores in that half the most notable coming from Sean Choi O'Broin, Aidan Mellett, Eoghan Monahan, young substitute Luke McDwyer and Aaron Coffey. James Holland, Cillian Byrne and the ever reliable Cathal Creed added the physical and hardworking dimension to the Boden play which was to eventually suffocate any hopes Crokes had of a revival.

Ballyboden now lead the way in the Minor A league by 4 points from Na Fianna who they must meet twice in the next round of matches which begin on September 4th. By then Championship time will almost be upon us.
