#### **Brendan Maher RIP**

It is with great sadness we report that on Thursday evening last, Brendan Maher former Ballyboden Senior Hurler and brother of the late Gerry Maher, lost his battle with cancer.

Brendan joined Ballyboden in 1985 from Oilgate in Wexford and was an immediate regular on the senior team. Having represented Wexford at U21 level he was one the most skilfull players ever to walk through our gates and lined out in the 1988 county final v Vincents at wing forward. Unfortunately we lost that final by 4 points but it was always one of his major regrets not to have achieved a senior medal with Boden. However he did partially fulfill his dream and won an intermediate county medal just before retirement. Once finished playing he quickly moved into management and helped to coach our seniors before moving back to Wexford.

Brendan served our club with distinction from the mid 80's until he returned to Rathnure in late 1998.He was a very loyal and popular friend to all those who were fortunate enough to know him and until his sad passing always remained interested in affairs of Boden.

He will be sadly missed by his wife Mary Barron, Anne, Brian, David and Denis, his extended family and his many many friends



# Closing of Pairc Uí Mhurchú

Pairc Uí Mhurchú will close on Monday 22nd August for major refurbishment . This will include lengthening, leveling and resurfacing with new boundary fence at Westbourne side. It will take approx 5-6 weeks to complete programme subject to weather conditions. While the work is in progress the top half of the car park will be used by the contractors with pedestrian access only to the dressing rooms. Unfortunately car parking spaces will be limited for this period and would appreciate members support during the development.
