Le Fear Bog reports from Minor A League Final Ballyboden St Enda's 2-14 Na Fianna 1-12.

Just as it was looking like the hurling year was about to end on a damp squid, unexpectedly Santa Clause arrived early to Sancta Maria to present the Division 1 Cup to the good boys of the Ballyboden Minor A squad. Of course, it wasn't the real Santa but a member of the county board but a welcome visitor all the same.

This was a victory that brought out the undoubted talent in this team and a performance that was anticipated all year was finally delivered to defeat the recently crowned county champions.

The foundations for the victory were laid down in the first 10 minutes as Boden raced in to a 1-3 to 0-0 lead. Aaron Coffey at corner forward was on fire as he accounted for 1-2 of this total. His goal in the 3rd minute was a brilliant piece of opportunism as he grasped a diagonal delivery from defence, turned his marker and sprinted 20 meters to deliver a bullet to the net. Shane Kennedy embellished the lead with some fine scores from both play and frees. Aidan Mellett was also prominent in this period and he would finish the match with 4 fine points from play.

By half time Ballyboden had established a lead of 2-7 to 0-1. Boden's second goal was a flick of a high delivery by the towering Eoghan Monahan just on the cusp of half time. Na Fianna demonstrated that they are worthy county champions in the second half and aided by a freshening breeze, which was strangely for Sancta Maria blowing from the east, they cut the lead down to 4 points with as many minutes left to the final whistle. The Na Fianna goal came in the 20th minute of the half from a penalty, the second one awarded to them on the day. Nervous times but Ballyboden showed tremendous resilience and character to finish off the job and once again Shane Kennedy was finisher in chief. In addition, points from captain James Holland and substitute Mikey Dunne put the result beyond the reach of the Mobhi Road side.


It was a busy morning at Cherryfield as the 2010 Girls and Academy Boys also had separate internal Blitzes among themselves.



After a long season of training and matches, the U10 boys squad finished up their year with a visit to the National Sports Campus at Abbotstown to play football and hurling matches against Na Fianna.

First impressions of the facility were most favourable as a group of boys made their way through the pavilion at the National Games Development Centre admiring the gymnasium and associated facilities. It was probably too much to expect that we would play on the replica Croke park pitch with up to 400 spectators in the stand cheering on. That's for some day in the future!

On Saturday we were allocated to a superb astro surface pitch that was rated highly by all. First up was three hurling matches played against well-organized Na Fianna boys. The large pitch and excellent surface suited our boys who played with an intensity and skill level that the coaches could have only dreamed of at the beginning of the season.

Points and goals were created and scored from all over the pitch providing great satisfaction for parents and coaches alike.

Next up were three football matches and despite getting off to a slow start, the boys rallied to the cause and put on an excellent display of football skills at a performance level worthy of a National Sports Centre.

Many thanks to Na Fianna for organising this set of games that was enjoyed by all. It was also a great way to wrap up the season and for the coaches to reflect on how far this group of boys has come in the past two years since beginning Go Games.

As they move on to the U11 grade, the future looks very bright for this group.

With 91 boys registered to play, attendance levels have been excellent throughout the year. Up to 28 matches (hurling and football) were played in the Go Games series and many boys also played in Tournaments (in Waterford, Clonmel, Naas, Blessington) and other Blitz, Feiles and friendlies closer to home.

All the coaches appreciate the efforts made by parents and guardians to get the boys to training and matches in good time, it makes the organising and running of sessions and matches much easier.

They look forward to seeing all of the boys again in late January for another fantastic season of Gaelic games.
