# Football News - Ending the Year on a High Note

Senior football league final v St Judes Parnell Park, Tuesday 13 December 2016 Ballyboden St Endas 2 – 18; St Judes 3 – 14 (after extra time) What a way to end the year and say our goodbyes to Andy McEntee. This league final victory closed the year on a high having started the year also on a high by winning the All-Ireland. The new manager certainly has good raw material when he takes over from Andy and all of the players on the panel for the league final were home grown players who all came up through the juvenile ranks. To be fair to the players who helped win the semi-final against Kilmacud Crokes, Andy picked the same starting team.

Judes started well and had two points on the board before a clinical finish by Sam Molony from a great pass from midfield found him inside his man and he duly rattled the net. Another long ball by Alan Flood found Darren O'Reilly who popped the ball over the bar. Sam Molony was causing havoc in the Judes defence and despite a heavy tackle he managed to kick his first point.

Kevin Macmenamin was having a quite game but when he got the ball on the end line and made one of his trademark runs along the line, things looked dangerous. However, the backs did not give him much room to go for goal so he tried to fist the ball over the bar. Unfortunately for us, the ball came back off the cross bar, hit against Stephen O'Connor and ended up in the net for a fortuitous goal. Judes scored two more points by the 15th minute to go two points up. Conal Keaney got a point back from a free before Judes restored their two point advantage. The remainder of the half belonged to Conal Keaney. On 19 minutes he converted a free, then a minute later scored from a line ball. Andrew Kerin and Ryan Basquel popped over a point each. Then Conal again got on the score sheet, this time from play. With half time approaching Conal finished with another converted free. A minute or two earlier, Michael Darragh McAuley replaced Declan O'Mahony who was injured. The half time score was 1-9 to 1-5.

Three substitutions were made at half time with Collie Basquel replacing Andrew Kerin, Shane Durkin replacing Collie Dunne and Shane Clayton replacing Stephen O'Connor. Before these players had a chance to get used to their new surroundings, Judes came out of the traps with intent and in just over a minute they had scored a point and a goal to bring the sides level. A Conal Keaney point from a free was cancelled out by a Judes point from play. Sam Molony and Aran Waters put us two points up again. Judes then scored four points without reply to go two points ahead again. However, they could not pull away as Aran Waters pulled one back. Stephen Hiney replaced Cathal Flaherty and Barra McGarry replaced Darren O'Reilly. Another Aran Waters point was cancelled out by a Judes pointed free. We were still a point behind with time running out but Conal Keaney brought the sides level with a pointed free. Ryan Basquel was black carded with normal time up but as we had used all our 6 subs, he could not be replaced. The final score was 1 – 15 to 2 - 12 so extra time had to be played.

Ronan Cleary could now replace Ryan Basquel. Points by Shane Durkin and Collie Basquel in the first half were cancelled out with 2 points from Judes so the sides were still level at half time. Mid-way through the second half, Ronan Cleary punched a point. Then Alan Flood disposed a Judes back, passed to Ronan Cleary who found Sam Molony unmarked near the goal. Sam's shot was partly blocked but crossed the line before Judes cleared it. One umpire brought this to the attention of the referee who awarded a goal, much to the annoyance of Judes. We now seemed to be home and hosed but Judes were not finished. They dropped a couple of balls into the square seeking a goal. When they eventually got a shot in, Stephen Hiney was penalised (harshly) for a foot bock and the referee awarded Judes a penalty, which they scored. The small crowd of Boden supporters were delighted and relieved to hear the final whistle after Darragh Gogan kicked the ball out. Captain Ryan Basquel picked up the cup.

Even though it was early in the week, there was a good celebration in the clubhouse

afterwards where Andy McEntee thanked the Club for the friendship and support he experienced over the last few years. Our Chairman Brendan Moran thanked Andy for the successes he had helped to bring to the Club and Brendan promised that we would all be supporting Andy's new team, Meath, when they play --- Fermanagh!!!!!!!!


