The 47th Annual General meeting of Ballyboden St. Endas Gaa, Camogie and Ladies Football Club will take place on Monday, April 24th 2017 at 8.30 p.m. in the club hall. All full members are cordially invited to attend this meeting, and are asked to attend promptly at 8.30pm so that a quorum would be formed and the meeting start on time. Full members are invited to nominate for election the Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, Secretary, Registrar, Officer for Irish Language and Culture, Public Relations Officer, Children's Officer, Player's Representative and 2 other Executive Committee Members. These shall be elected by the Full Members present, entitled to vote at the Annual General Meeting.

The other 7 members of the Executive Committee shall be selected as representatives of the following Executive Sub-Committees, Games Development & Coaching, Adult Games, Juvenile Games, Social Activities, IT & Communication Structures, Club Development, Grounds Maintenance, by the elected members of the incoming Executive Committee. The elected and selected members shall meet the eligibility criteria set out in paragraph 8.2 of the Club Bye Laws and Rules. The written consent of nominees must accompany each nomination. Full members are also invited to propose motions for consideration at the AGM, in accordance with the club constitution.

Nominations for election to the Executive Committee and motions for consideration by the AGM should be received by the club secretary not less than 21 days before the AGM i.e. by Monday April 3rd. Motions may be sent by email to the Secretary at the email address secretary.ballybodenstendas.dublin@gaa.ie or addressed to the Club Secretary and posted or handed to the Club. Please note that nomination and motion forms will be available behind the Bar.

The annual club membership fee must be paid before the AGM in orderfor members to participate in the meeting. Please note that in order to reduce cost, the Executive Committee have decided not to print hardcopies of the Annual Report but to circulate it by email and to publish it on the Club website.

Buffer's Alley Pip Boden

Buffer's Alley Pip Boden – Joe Wordsworth reports from Avondale

Ballyboden senior hurlers relinquished their Leinster League Division 1 title on Tuesday 11th April in the beautiful Garden County setting of Avondale against Buffers Alley from Wexford.

On a fine evening, Boden set out with intent and got the scoring underway with a point from Niall Ryan. The workrate of all, particularly the forwards, was impressive in this opening quarter with blocks, hooks and great running off the ball on display. Eoghan O'Néill typified this effort as he led the charge. Further points from Rob Leddy, Aidan Mellet, James Roche and Paul Doherty saw Boden pull clear early on. When a high ball was sent in after about 10 minutes, it was partially cleared but Mellet was first to react and the green flag was raised. A pair of Paul Ryan frees rounded off an impressive first quarter. A series of frees brought Buffers Alley back into contention – a product of strong running as well. More worrying was the loss to Boden of both Dean Curran and Paul Ryan through injury. Still the pace continued and Boden went in at half time 1-11 to 0-10 ahead.

Boden again started well with points from Roche & O'Néill increasing the lead. The Wexford men steadied and found the net themselves. Malachy Travers, Stephen Hiney and Conor Robinson were clearing good ball but Buffers Alley had increased the pace noticeably. They now had the momentum and with five minutes to go, were three points ahead. Boden came again and this caused the defence to foul – Roche fired over three placed balls, the last in

injury time to bring it level. As we anticipated extra time, Buffers Alley launched one more attack and sent a long-range effort over the bar. There was barely time for the puckout. A brave fight but Boden came up just short in a very good tussle. This match will stand to the players later in the year, particularly the younger group.
