Dublin Minor footballers through to Championship All-Ireland Semi-final

Dublin minor footballers booked their berth in the last four of this year's All-Ireland Electric Ireland MFC with a quarter-final victory at O'Moore Park, Portlaoise on Monday afternoon.

Ballyboden were well presented with Ross McGarry and Kieran Kennedy in the starting 15. Ross was Dublin's scorer-in-chief finishing with a tally of 2-4 (0-3f). Dublin had been forced into making one change to their starting team. Boden's James Madden, one of the Dubs best performers in the Leinster MFC Final victory over Louth, was unfortunately ruled out through injury.

The Dubs will now face Derry in their All-Ireland MFC semi-final on Sunday, August 27th (1.30pm) – the curtain-raiser to the senior clash of Dublin and Tyrone.

Bitter defeat for U17 hurlers in All-Ireland Final



Dublin's under-17 hurlers had hoped to create history by being crowned the Inaugural All-Ireland U17 Hurling Champions when they faced Cork in last Sunday's decider in Croke Park. Included in the U17 Dublin team and starting on the day were Boden's Kevin Desmond and Luke McDiwyer.

Following an impressive Leinster campaign, the U17 Leinster Champions received a walkover from Antrim in the previous weekend's All-Ireland semi-final.

The Dubs showed great spirit on the day and kept working to the limit despite operating with 14 men from the 43rd minute however their efforts were narrowly thwarted by the Leesiders with Cork running out winners 1:19 to 1:17.

Dublin will look to avenge this defeat to some degree when they face Cork in the minor semi-final in next weekend's curtain-raiser in Croke Park. Many of the U17 panel are also on the minor panel. we wish them the Best of Luck.
