Paul Rouse played football and hurling for Tullamore and is presently a member of the St. Oliver Plunkett Eoghan Ruadh club in Dublin where he is involved as a juvenile hurling and ladies football mentor. In 2018, he stepped into the breach as manager of the Offaly senior football team. He is the author of several books including his latest work, "The Hurlers", which

tells the story of the birth of the modern game in that first All-Ireland final 132 years ago. Paul was recently featured in the RTÉ documentary, **Players of the Faithful**, which recalled in his words "the most famous one in a row in football" when Offaly beat a Kerry team on the cusp of a record five-in-a-row of All-Ireland Senior titles in 1982.

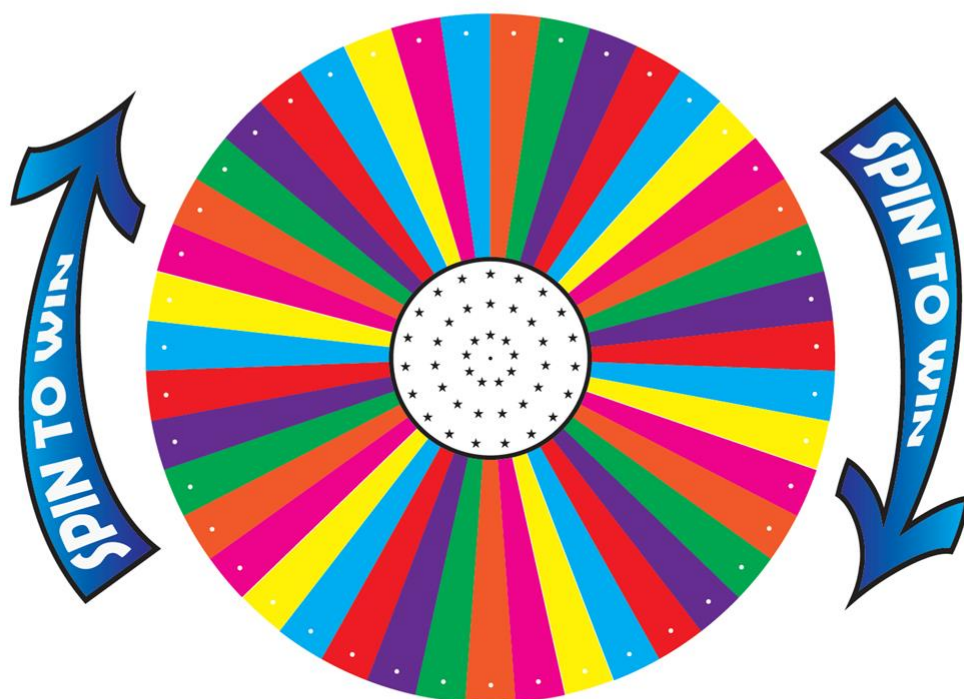
With regard to mandatory workshops (Foundation course & Child Protection Course) can you ensure that if they have not yet completed these courses, they do so with a matter of urgency.
