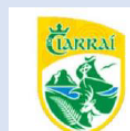

Junior C Championship Play Off – An Fear Bog Reports from O’ Toole Park

Ballyboden St. Enda’s 4-12 Na Gael Oga 2-11

A number of weeks ago these two sides played out a frantic draw in the Junior C Championship group stage. This necessitated a play off match on Wednesday evening last at O’Toole Park to decide who would top the group and secure a home quarter final. The first half of this tie was almost a carbon copy of the previous encounter with very little to separate both sides.

Ballyboden got off to a whirlwind start and had 1-1 on the scoreboard before Na Gael Oga could get their feet on the ground. Straight from the throw in Dave Keville split the posts for a point and almost immediately Gavin Duff got a flick to a high delivery to give Boden the perfect start. By the 8th minute, however, Na Gael Oga had levelled at 1-1 apiece. Their goal was worth the entrance fee of €3 alone as their full forward volleyed to the net from a very acute angle. Na Gael Oga took over for a period and a succession of frees had them 4 points up by the 15th minute. Dave Keville added Boden's second major in the 18th minute when his high lop deceived the Na Gael Oga keeper and landed in the net. Both sides remained in a tight head lock from there to the half time break and it was a point from Sean Gorman, the hero of the drawn match, on the stroke of half time which gave Boden a slender half time lead of 2-6 to 1-8.

Boden took command of the second half to finally shake off a stubborn Na Gael Oga. Two quick goals early in the half put daylight between the sides which was held to the finish. In the 8th minute of the half Ciaran Twomey caught a puck out from Marc MacLiam, put Hugh Nolan in the clear who delivered to Brian Cummins who blasted the net. A few minutes later Nolan again set up Cummins whose thunderous shot was well stopped by the goalkeeper but James Hanrahan follow up to sent the rebound to the net. Sin deireadh an sceal and in the closing stages Boden put a blas on their victory with some fine points especially from the camán of Ciaran Twomey. At the other end of the pairc the Boden defence did not give an inch with Cathal Ryan in command at full back while Sean Lambert provided speed and skill to lock down the half back line. It's onwards now to the quarter finals

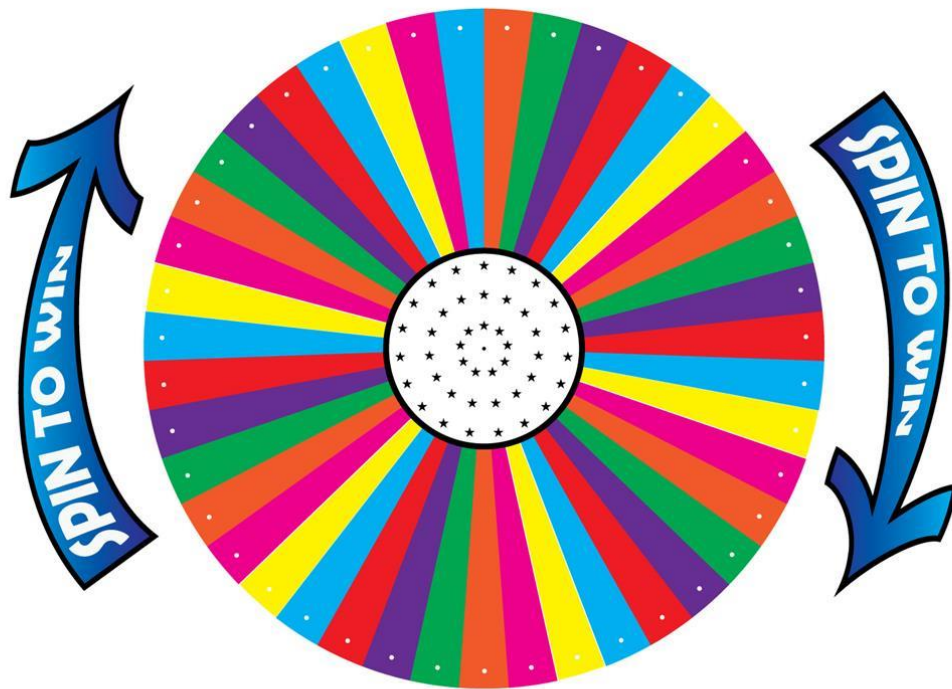
Gaelic games can be physical sports, and, while collisions are not a primary element of our games, they can occasionally happen. There has been an increasing number of concussion injuries over the past year, and it is important that team managers, mentors and first aid people can recognise the symptoms and know the correct actions to take in order to ensure the safety of the player. Player safety is the most important consideration in a concussion, or any injury situation. It is widely reported that an inter-county player collapsed in a dressing room a week after an initial concussion diagnosis.

SPARC lead physiotherapist, Eamon O'Reilly has kindly created the below protocol for dealing with concussion and shared the GAA Medical Scientific Welfare committee guidelines, and we ask all those involved with teams to familiarise themselves with the guidelines and with the 'If in Doubt, Site Them Out' tag line. In order to ensure player welfare and to collate club data on the occurrence of concussion injuries, SPARC will see any club member with a concussion or suspected concussion free of charge, and we strongly encourage club players to avail of this generous and important offer.
