Senior football Leinster championship final V Éire Óg in Portlaoise, 8 December 2019



**Ballyboden St Endas 0 – 8;
Éire Óg 0 – 6**

Great credit is due to all the players who managed to play football in this Leinster final on a day when the weather was the topic of conversation. But play they did and, thankfully, Boden won their second Leinster football title in four years – a nice way to bring our 50th anniversary celebrations to a close.

Playing against the wind in the first half, Boden did most of the attacking but could not break down the Éire Óg defence, although Collie Basquel came close but his goal chance was smothered by their goalkeeper. Éire Óg were first to score in the 10th minute with a point and added two more in quick succession to go three points to no score in front. It took another 10 minutes for Boden to score. A 45 was taken by Darragh Gogan but, due to the strength of the wind, it dropped short. The dropping ball was fielded by Conal Keaney who passed to Collie Basquel and he popped it over the bar to open the scoring. Conal Keaney got on the score

board with a well taken point after a patient build up and then, as half time approached, a Ryan Basquel free brought the sides level at half time on three points each.

Playing with the wind in the second half, it was hoped that Boden would be able to convert the advantage to scores. However, this was easier said than done and Éire Óg showed why they were in the final by their resolute defence and attacking ability. The first score in the 2nd half came from Collie Basquel when he fisted over the bar after six minutes. Éire Óg cancelled this out almost immediately. Conal Keaney put Boden back in front a few minutes later but this too was quickly cancelled out. As the end of the game approached, Éire Óg launched another attack and knocked over what looked like the winner. However, the character of the Boden team was called on again and to great cheering Warren Egan popped over the equaliser while under some pressure, as normal time drew to a close. Extra time looked a certainty but captain Ryan Basquel led from the front and put his side a point ahead with additional time almost up. However, there was time to put the icing on the cake and the task was left to Michael Darragh Macauley, who, after his team mates won the Éire Óg knockout and passed to him, raced through and fisted over the bar to leave the Boden management and followers ecstatic and relieved. The celebrations could now begin.

The scoring was low in this game due to great displays by both sets of backs and on the Boden side the full back line of Bob Dwan, Shane Clayton and Cathal Flaherty were Scrooge-like and gave little away, with Bob winning the Man of the Match accolade.

So, a great year is coming to an end with the team adding the Leinster championship to the county championship. Next Tuesday week (17 December) gives the team an opportunity to add the league to its haul when they play Ballymun in the league final in Parnell Park.



If in Doubt, Sit Them Out


Gaelic games can be physical sports, and, while collisions are not a primary element of our games, they can occasionally happen. There has been an increasing number of concussion injuries over the past year, and it is important that team managers, mentors and first aid people can recognise the symptoms and know the correct actions to take in order to ensure the safety of the player. Player safety is the most important consideration in a concussion, or any injury situation. It is widely reported that an inter-county player collapsed in a dressing room a week after an initial concussion diagnosis.

SPARC lead physiotherapist, Eamon O'Reilly has kindly created the below protocol for dealing with concussion and shared the GAA Medical Scientific Welfare committee guidelines, and we ask all those involved with teams to familiarise themselves with the guidelines and with the 'If in Doubt, Site Them Out' tag line. In order to ensure player welfare and to collate club data on the occurrence of concussion injuries, SPARC will see any club member with a concussion or suspected concussion free of charge, and we strongly encourage club players to avail of this generous and important offer.
